Expectations and Procedures

Team Rules:

We expect you to follow all school rules in addition to the following team rules, which are designed to create a positive learning environment for all of us:

1. Be in class on time.
2. Have all of your materials ready to use and be in your seat when the bell rings.
3. Follow instructions when they are given.
4. Raise your hand and wait to be called on.
5. Stay in your seat unless you have permission to do otherwise.
6. Be respectful.

Homework/Practice Guidelines:

- ✓ Check your assignment calendar daily for all team homework/practice.
- ✓ Homework/Practice *must* be neat, complete, and turned in on time.
- ✓ All homework must be emailed to your teachers by the due date.
- ✓ LATE HOMEWORK: All homework is due on the assigned day. Students with late or missing work will be asked to stay in at recess on the following days: Mondays/Fridays: Math, Tuesdays: Science, Wednesdays: Language Arts, Thursdays: Social Studies.
- ✓ Homework Link: An estimate of each week's topics and assignments can be accessed through individual teacher's websites. Go to <http://viking.d56.org/>, Staff Directory, and then click on a teacher's name. Homework/Practice can also be found on your assignment calendar.
- ✓ Please check Skyward often to track your progress and homework completion. This is an excellent way for you and your parents to stay informed.
- ✓ All students who maintain C's or better in their core classes and do not receive any major referrals will be eligible for midterm and quarterly reward days.

Absences:

- ✓ ANTICIPATED ABSENCES: Please make an effort to get your assignment before you leave. We will do our best to supply you with all the necessary work.
- ✓ UNEXPECTED ABSENCES: In compliance with school procedures, you may request homework if you are absent two consecutive days.

Make-up Work:

- ✓ It is YOUR responsibility to meet with the teacher and get the assignment from the assignment board.
- ✓ If a test has been previously scheduled and you are absent the day before the test, you will be expected to take the test with the rest of the class.
- ✓ If you are present for all of the material on a chapter test, but miss the day of the test, expect to make-up the test on the day you return. That may require you to make it up during lunch or CA.

Grading Scale:

Passes to leave class:

- ✓ You must have a pass to leave class for any reason.
- ✓ You will have 3 bathroom passes for each core class per quarter. Extra bathroom passes can be obtained with VIP vouchers.

Class Economy System:

- ✓ The class economy system is used to motivate students. VIP Vouchers are awarded for various reasons, but not limited to: good behavior, assignment completion, high performance on tests/quizzes, participation, etc.

Class Dismissal:

- ✓ When the dismissal bell rings, please remain in your seats until the teacher dismisses you.
- ✓ Be sure to check the area around you and under your desk. Take your belongings with you.

Other Important Procedures:

- ✓ All class work *must* be written neatly. This includes notes, assignments, and homework.
- ✓ When using the iPad, neatness still counts. If you are unable to write neatly with your fingers or stylus, you must use the type function.

Activity Days:

- ✓ Activity Days are a privilege for those students who consistently turn homework in on time and follow the Viking Basic Training Policies and Procedures.
