

6 RED IPAD RULES

· **When we are not using the iPad, you will hear us say “apples up.” This means the screen should be face down.**

· **When you are using your iPad in class, your iPad should be FLAT on the desk at all times.**

1. These iPads are for learning. It is a privilege to use them.
2. You are to use only **your own** iPad, unless given specific permission by your teacher.
3. When using the iPads, your volume should be turned off unless otherwise directed by the teacher.
4. When using your iPad, you must be on the correct site, app, etc..., or you will be considered off task and will receive consequences accordingly.
5. The camera is not to be used for any reason unless given explicit permission or direction by your teacher.
6. **YOU** are responsible for maintaining **YOUR** iPad. This means your iPad is expected to be fully charged each school day. It is **YOUR** responsibility to keep your iPad with you at all times. If you leave your iPad anywhere, **YOU** are responsible for anything that happens to it (damage or lost).
7. Headphones/ear buds are required as a necessary school supply. They will be used in all of your core classes. Come prepared to class. Minor referrals will be given if headphones are not with you for your classes and you do not have VIP vouchers to “rent” them. Three minor referrals will result in a major referral.

8. Dropping your iPad is not showing how to "Be Responsible." A minor referral will be issued to any student each time the iPad is dropped. After 3 dropping minors, the student will receive a major referral.

9. When using the Ipad you are to follow all school and 6 Red rules and expectations. Any expectations or rules broken will result in consequences, and may result in the loss of your Ipad.
